- 1.—THIS BOOK WILL BE PRODUCED WHENEVER AN ADVANCE OF PAY IS REQUIRED.
- 2.—THE SOLDIER WILL GIVE A RECEIPT ON AN ACQUITTANCE ROLL FOR ALL CASH ADVANCES. THE OFFICER MAKING THE PAYMENT WILL SIGN THE CORRESPONDING ENTRY IN THIS BOOK ON THE PAGE FOR CASH PAYMENTS.
- 3.—THIS BOOK IS THE PROPERTY OF THE CANADIAN GOVERNMENT. A SOLDIER WHO LOSES IT BY NEGLIGENCE, OR ALTERS ANY OFFICIAL ENTRY IN SAME, OR MAKES UNAUTHORISED ENTRIES THEREIN, MAY BE CHARGED WITH A SERIOUS OFFENCE UNDER THE ARMY ACT. CARE SHOULD BE TAKEN AT ALL TIMES TO GUARD AGAINST LOSS, AND ON NO ACCOUNT ARE UNAUTHORISED ENTRIES TO BE MADE. THE HOLDER IS PERMITTED TO ENTER ONLY HIS SIGNATURE ON PAGES 4 AND 7, AND HIS WILL ENTRIES ON PAGES 18 AND 19.
- 4.—IF THIS PAY BOOK IS LOST, THE SOLDIER WILL REPORT THE LOSS TO HIS COMMANDING OFFICER IMMEDIATELY. A NEW BOOK WILL BE ISSUED BY THE PAYMASTER, AFTER ENQUIRY HAS BEEN MADE, AND ENTRIES FROM THE CONDUCT SHEET HAVE BEEN INCORPORATED THEREIN ON PAGE 7.
- 5.—THIS PAY BOOK IS ONLY A MEMORANDUM OF PAYMENTS AND CHARGES. IT IS NOT THE FULL ACCOUNT OF A SOLDIER, AND ON DISCHARGE FROM THE SERVICE, OR WHEN REQUIRED IT MUST BE DELIVERED TO THE PAYMASTER. IF THE HOLDER IS PROMOTED TO COMMISSIONED RANK, THIS BOOK MUST BE FORWARDED TO THE CHIEF PAYMASTER.
- 6.—THE PAY BOOK SHOULD ALWAYS BE KEPT IN THE INSIDE BREAST POCKET OF THE TUNIC. IT SHOULD ON NO ACCOUNT BE PLACED IN THE KIT BAG. THE LOSS OF A PAY BOOK CAUSES MUCH INCONVENIENCE TO THE SOLDIER.

FOR PERSONAL ESTATE ONLY.

IT IS MOST IMPORTANT THAT EVERY SOLDIER SHOULD MAKE A WILL. THIS SHOULD BE DONE UNDER THE DIRECTION OF THE PAYMASTER. IF A SOLDIER, ON ACTIVE SERVICE, OR UNDER ORDERS FOR ACTIVE SERVICE, WISHES TO MAKE A SHORT WILL, HE MAY DO SO ON PAGE 18. IT MUST BE ENTIRELY IN HIS OWN HANDWRITING, AND MUST BE SIGNED BY HIM AND DATED, THE FULL NAMES AND ADDRESSES OF THE PERSONS WHOM HE DESIRES TO BENEFIT, AND THE SUM OF MONEY OR THE ARTICLES OR PROPERTY WHICH HE DESIRES TO LEAVE TO THEM MUST BE CLEARLY STATED. THE MERE ENTRY OF THE NAME OF AN INTENDED LEGATEE ON PAGE 18 WITHOUT ANY MENTION OF WHAT THE LEGATEE IS TO RECEIVE IS OF NO LEGAL VALUE, AND NAMING ANYONE AS NEXT-OF-KIN IS NOT A WILL, AND DOES NOT NECESSARILY BENEFIT THE PERSON IN THE CASE OF A SOLDIER'S DEATH.

The following is a Specimen of a Will leaving all to one person:—

In the event of my Death I give the whole of my Property and Effects to my Mother, Mrs. Mary Atkins, 999, High Street, Aldershot.

IF IT IS DESIRED TO LEAVE REAL ESTATE TO ANYONE, THEN A FORMAL WILL MUST BE EXECUTED IN THE PRESENCE OF TWO WITNESSES, BOTH PRESENT AND AT THE SAME TIME, AND SIGNING IT IN THE PRESENCE OF THE TESTATOR AND OF EACH OTHER. 2.—IF THE ADDRESS OF HIS NEXT-OF-KIN, *i.e.*, WIFE, FATHER, MOTHER, ETC., HAS BEEN CHANGED SINCE HE ENLISTED, HE SHOULD IMMEDIATELY NOTIFY SUCH CHANGE TO THE PAYMASTER, AND HAVE THE NEW PARTICULARS NOTED BY THAT OFFICER ON PAGE 1 OF THIS BOOK. IN THE SAME WAY, ANY CHANGE OF ASSIGNMENT SHOULD BE NOTED THEREON.

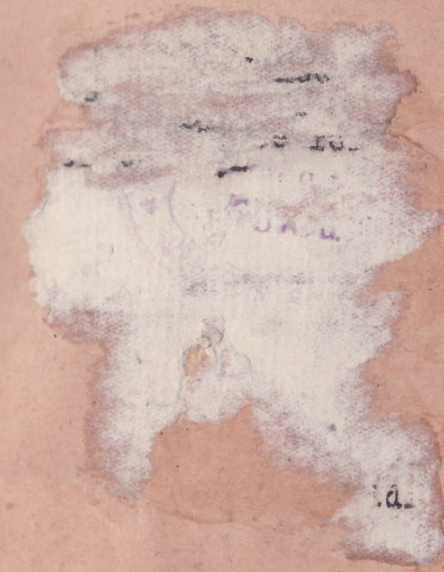
3.—IF A MAN IS SENT TO HOSPITAL, HIS PAY BOOK IS TO REMAIN IN HIS POSSESSION. IF HE REQUIRES POCKET MONEY, OR STAMPS, ETC., WHILE IN HOSPITAL, HE WILL APPLY TO THE MEDICAL OFFICER.

4.—IF A MAN DESIRES TO ASCERTAIN THE STATE OF HIS PAY ACCOUNT, HE SHOULD APPLY TO THE REGIMENTAL PAYMASTER.

5.—TO AVOID TROUBLE AND EXPENSE TO RELATIVES, EVERY MAN SHOULD MAKE OUT HIS WILL, WHICH SHOULD BE SENT TO THE OFFICER *in charge* ESTATES BRANCH, 133, OXFORD STREET, LONDON, W.1., BY THE REGIMENTAL PAYMASTER, UNLESS THE WILL HAS BEEN MADE OUT IN CANADA BEFORE THE MAN CAME OVERSEAS, IN WHICH CASE THE INFORMATION COULD BE NOTED ON PAGE 19. THE NOMINATION OF A PERSON BY A SOLDIER AS HIS NEXT-OF-KIN IS NOT A WILL, AND DOES NOT GIVE THAT PERSON ANY RIGHT TO THE SOLDIER'S ARREARS OF PAY OR EFFECTS WHICH FORM A PART OF HIS MILITARY ESTATE. IN THE ABSENCE OF A WILL THE ESTATE IS DISTRIBUTED UNDER THE LAW OF THE SOLDIER'S PLACE OF DOMICILE, AND VARIOUS RELATIVES WOULD RECEIVE THEIR LEGAL SHARE, WHICH MAY RESULT IN THE PERSON WHOM THE SOLDIER WISHES TO BENEFIT HAVING NO LEGAL CLAIM TO ANYTHING AT ALL, OR PERHAPS TO ONLY A SHARE.
